

City of Lenoir – Sewer & Water Improvement Projects Finley Ave. & Ridge St.



Ridge Street Sewer Project - Construction can start work as early as Monday, Oct. 27. One lane of Ridge Street and West Avenue will be closed during the project. Drivers should use caution and pay attention in the area. Contractors are working with the Fire Department to ensure that City fire trucks can get into and out of Fire Station 1 without problems. The contractors plan to finish the project by late January. Once the sewer line is rerouted, the City will work to reroute the storm drain line and then fill the sinkhole by
