- **Mandatory NSPIRE inspection March 9<sup>th</sup>**  
An inspector will be on-site and accompanied by a member of the maintenance team as inspections are completed. Residents do not need to be present during the inspection. We ask that all residents ensure their unit is in orderly condition and that all rooms are accessible.
- **Video Surveillance:**  
New Camera Systems have been installed on property for the safety of our residents
